

Museum of Marrakech

Palais Badia

An immense palace in ruins with massive garden area and prison cells, the main plan of the site mimics Alhambra in Granada, built by Sultan Ahmed el-Mansour, and ornamented by gold and precious rocks, before Moulay Ismaïl ordered its demolition 75 years later and all the valuables to be transferred to his own palace in Meknes (1696)



Built in 1900, this place has been a residence for many powerful men, before turning it into a museum by the great collectioner Omar Benjelloun, we can find texts and photos documenting the history of the place



Saadian Tombs

Finding the entrance of the tombs is a challenge which explains why they were only re-discovered in 1917 by French archaeologists. Story says that Sultan Moulay Ismail built blocking walls to imprison the souls of his predecessors. There is about sixty tombs covered in ceramic for the common people, then some prestigious ones in the isolated mausoleums





Most people associate Marrakech with night life and festive activities, they are not wrong, but the city also offers some wonderful gardens where you can admire the mesmerizing nature, the vibrant colors of vegetation, and reconnect with mother earth



Each of these gardens was first made/built/designed for a purpose by their creators, however, they have something in common, they were all created with so much love and passion, and once you visit them, you can definitely tell

Paradis du Safran

The two and half acre botanical garden was created by the French Orientalist artist Jacques Majorelle starting in 1923, and features a Cubist villa in special shade of bold cobalt blue, inspired by the coloured tiles seen across the country

Christine Ferrari, a lovely Swiss lady, runs an organic saffron plantation that is definitely true to its name. The property includes a large garden with herbs and medicinal plants, citrus fruits and exotic plants, as well as stables with donkeys, peacocks, and chicken.





During the 16th century, powers including Spain, England, the Netherlands and France tried in vain to conquer the locality. Essaouira remained a haven for the export of sugar and molasses and as an anchorage for pirates (not anymore thankfully),

Essaouira is one of the most peaceful towns of Morocco with a slow paced lifestyle apart from the nautical sports on its beaches



Ait benhaddou is a well know destination in the south of Marrakech. the day trip covers about 180 km on way but the scenery is quite enjoyable, as each turn displays different views, colors, vegetation and village styles. You will cross the highest pass of Tizi N'Tichka, snowy part in the winter, then descend for a while through the twisty road of Telouet valley, home to another famous kasbah of Morocco, owned by a previous Kaid Galoui. Once in Ait benhadou, you choose which to have first, a delicious lunch meal in one of the restaurants or the guided walking visit of the antic village and a climb to its top to get a great view of the whole valley

Ait benhaddou is declared a world heritage by the UNESCO and is widely as a shooting movies scenes for works as popular as Game of Thrones

ITINERARY:

Day 1: Marrakech to Zagora


Departing from Marrakech, we will head south-east towards the Atlas mountains where will cross the highest pass in Morocco, Tizi'N'Tichka with its 2160 m of altitude. We will take a detour from the main road and descend through the beautiful valley of Ounila to stop in Telouet and visit its Kasbah, once home to Pacha Glaoui, landlord and governor of Marrakech region. Continuing our way through the same valley, we will arrive to the Ksar of Ait benhaddou, a UNESCO world heritage site that served as a backdrop for many cinematic projects. to fully explore the site, you will have a walking visit with a local guide to ascend to the top of the old village. Leaving Ait benhaddou, we will pass Ouarzazate, once named the gate of the desert, also home to the cinema industry in Morocco, then continue south-east crossing Agdez and Draa valley with its palm groves before reaching our hotel in Zagora to spend the night after a nice dinner.

Day 2: Zagora to the heart of Chegaga


After breakfast, we will continue our journey South, crossing many berber and saharian villages, the area can already be considered a desert for most people, but we're just getting started. We will stop at Tamegrout if you are interested in seeing the pottery industry. Arriving at Mhamid El Ghizlan announces the end of the Asphalt and the beginning of the real wilderness where only experienced drivers dare to go, rocky and rough terrain and sandy routes then small dunes then medium dunes for about 50 km before we reach the camp site... !! Once there, you can enjoy your camel ride to witness a majestic sunset and the true meaning of freedom in that vast golden world. And Even in this middle of nowhere, you can still rest, take a shower, have some mint tea and enjoy the moment, dinner will be served at the camp's restaurant and musical plays are held around fire.

Day 3: Chegaga to Marrakech

After breakfast, we will say goodbye to our hosts in the camp, buckle up and hit the road, in the opposite direction we came from, towards Foum Zguid this time, with another 80 km of off-road ahead, including the plain dry lake of Iriki where you can even race. We Once in Foum Zguid, we will encounter the asphalt road once more and head north via Taznakht until we rejoin our day 1 road near Ait benhaddou and continue towards Marrakech, lunch stop can be arranged with your driver during the tour to best suit your needs.

ITINERARY:

Day 1: Marrakech to Dades

Departing from Marrakech, we will head south-east towards the Atlas mountains where will cross the highest pass in Morocco, Tizi'N'Tichka with its 2160 m of altitude, this mountain chain is a natural barrier that separates two different atmospheres. After descending for a while, we will take a detour to visit the Ksar of Ait benhaddou, a UNESCO world heritage site that served as a backdrop for many cinematic projects. We will have lunch in one of its restaurants and a walking visit with a local guide to ascend to the top of the old village and get a wonderful view of the whole valley.


Leaving Ait benhaddou, we will pass Ouarzazate, once named the gate of the desert, also home to the cinema industry in Morocco, then continue east crossing Skoura valley with its palm groves and the valley of Roses (season between April and May) before reaching Dades gorges where will take a detour to reach our hotel in the heart of the valley to spend the night.

Day 2: Dades to Merzouga

After breakfast, we will continue our journey towards Tinghir, where will take another detour to visit the Todra gorges and its magnificent canyons and green valley in the middle of an arid mountainous area. Lunch stop will be later on the way depending on the day pace and hunger meter. After a couple of hours drive, we will start to see the golden dunes in the horizon looking like a mesmerizing oil painting in the distance. Your driver will take you to the edge of the dunes where you will meet your cameleers and the camp staff, once your scarfs fixed, you can ride the camels and depart in a caravan over the dunes while your luggage will be transported to your tents in the SUV. The caravan will also end up at the camp, where you can rest, take a shower, have some mint tea and enjoy the natural entourage, dinner will be served at the camp's restaurant and musical plays are held around fire.

Day 3: Merzouga to Marrakech

After an energetic breakfast, you will head back to the desert edge you started from, you have the choice between riding the camels back or by SUV (quicker). It is time to say goodbye to the Sahara and to your camel friends, and begin the long road-trip taking you back to Marrakech, the first part will be on a different route, you can nap and rest while the vehicle crosses the vast planes of Alnif. The day will only include short breaks to stretch out and one for lunch to compensate for the long distance.




