






Saadian Tombs






Anima garden


Agafay is probably THEE best place to try quad riding, the open view and awesome offroad paths are quite suitable for machine madness.





WINDY COASTAL CHARM

Essaouira is the closest coastal city to Marrakech, with the Atlantic ocean breathing its kind breeze on this beautiful town that was always a shelter for ocean navigators and traders, Essaouira was occupied by the Portuguese and called Castelo Real de Mogador during the 14th century. During the 16th century, powers including Spain, England, the Netherlands and France tried in vain to conquer the locality. Essaouira remained a haven for the export of sugar and molasses and as an anchorage for pirates (not anymore thankfully),

A DESCRIPTION OF STREET



Ait benhaddou is a well know destination in the south of Marrakech. the day trip covers about 180 km on way but the scenery is quite enjoyable, as each turn displays different views, colors, vegetation and village styles. You will cross the highest pass of Tizi N'Tichka, then descend through the twisty road of Telouet valley, home to another famous kasbah of Morocco, owned by a previous Kaid Galoui. Once in Ait benhadou, you choose which to have first, a delicious lunch meal in one of the restaurants or the guided walking visit of the antic village and a climb to its top to get a great view of the whole valley

WATERFALLS & MACAQUES

Ouzoud falls is the collective name for several waterfalls that empty into the El-Abid River's. And the term 'Ouzoud' means "the act of grinding grain" in Berber. This seems to be confirmed by the frequent mills in the region. In the vicinity, green valleys, mills, orchards and a superb circuit of the gorges of the El-Abid River are found. Many local and national associations lead projects to protect and preserve the site.





If the rocky desert of Zagora is not enough to satisfy your curiosity to see real dunes and sand but still only have 2 days to spare, continuing on the same route for an extra 100 km will have you arrive at the edge of Morocco in that direction and to the Sahara of Mhamid El Ghizlan. Once there, you will get a real feel of the desert, with it's magical palm trees as the main vegetation surviving the arid and desertic atmosphere of the region, you will see the golden dunes and ride the camels through them to reach your camp for the night



Located in the foothills of the High Atlas Mountains, the Ourika Valley is an ideal day trip for nature lovers or whoever wants to take a break from the city. As we leave Marrakech behind, the landscape becomes greener and a beautiful drive of about 50 kilometres will take you to this valley, with its olive groves, orchards, agricultural fields, amazing mountain scenery and of course the Ourika river. We will drive through charming villages and you will have the opportunity to experience traditional Berber way of life as we stop at a local family where you will enjoy fresh mint tea and visit a Berber museum. On Mondays only, it is also possible to visit a typical Berber market. We will finally reach Setti Fatma, the last village accessible by road and the starting point for hiking trips in the Atlas Mountains. You will finally enjoy an authentic Moroccan lunch on the banks of the river and after that we will drive back to Marrakech
